**Subject:- Minutes of the Meeting held on 31-12-2018 in the office chambers of
Controller Legal Metrology Department, Transport Nagar, Narwal, Jammu.**

A meeting of the following officers of Legal Metrology Department chaired by Controller Legal Metrology Department was held on 31-12-2018 at 11:00 AM in his office chambers at Narwal, Jammu:-

1. Mr. Amar Singh, Joint Controller, Legal Metrology Department, Jammu.
2. Mr. Manoj Prabhakar, Deputy Controller, Consumer Protection, Jammu.
3. Mr. Mohammad Amin, Accounts Officer, Legal Metrology Department.

During the course of meeting the following issues were discussed and on spot decisions taken thereof including implementation of EAT module in Central Sector Schemes in particular:-

I) EAT Module and Executing Agency:-

It was unanimously decided that for sustained and quality execution of works the Legal Metrology Department will continue with the J&K Housing Board as an Executing Agency for works under CSS "Strengthening of Legal Metrology Infrastructure in States/UTs" on the reason that the Department has already released the funds for various ongoing works taken in hand. Moreover the Administrative charges/agency charges are on lower side other than the executing agencies like PWD/JKPCC etc. Besides quality of work shall remain part of consideration. Accounts Officer Legal Metrology Department shall submit the proforma for EAT module to Govt. of India accordingly.

II) Excess Amounts released to J&K Housing Board:-

a) During the course of meeting it was also decided that a comprehensive list of all the Projects shall be framed depicting therein the amount released to the J&K Housing Board with excess/balance statement so that the issue is taken up with Managing Director J&K Housing Board to complete pending works of ongoing Projects.

b) The issue regarding release of RS. 25.00 Lacs for Food Testing Laboratory to J&K Housing Board released during 03/2018 also remained under threadbare discussion. It was apprised by the Deputy Controller, Consumer Protection, Jammu (being Nodal Officer) that initially the proposal was sent to the Govt. for Purchase of Equipments in order to check food grains but the

sanction was accorded by the Administrative Department for Construction of Food Laboratory. The amount stands already released to the J&K Housing Board during 03/2018. Further, it was decided to move a proposal to the Administrative Department for utilizing this amount for Purchase of Laboratory Equipments by way of withdrawal of money from J&K Housing Board as there is no specific land available with the Department for construction of Food Testing Lab. Alternatively we can have a review to authorize the J&K Housing Board to adjust that amount on running projects.

III) Operationalisation of Karat-Meter:-

During the course of meeting, it was also decided that a proposal will be submitted to the Administrative Department for making public aware about the use of Karat-Meter with nominal fee of (Rs. 20 to Rs. 50) per ornament to make the Karat-meter functional at Jammu.

IV) Revenue Targets and Fee Revision :-

The fixation of the Revenue Targets for the current financial year 2018-19 also remained under discussion. The Controller, Legal Metrology Department has advised both Joint Controller, LMD, Jammu & Deputy Controller, Consumer Protection, Jammu to move proposal for revision of Stamping fee with full justification enabling this office to send the Proposal to the Administrative Department.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to chair.
